Fast-track your nursing career, prepare to be challenged, and enjoy a mix of clinical and classroom learning.

Upon passing the NCLEX-RN national licensure exam, you will be eligible to practice nursing in all health care settings – including acute care, ambulatory care, community health, and mental health.

Closer Than You Think – Admission Requirements

- An earned baccalaureate degree from any undergraduate major with a minimum 3.0 GPA (3.3 GPA preferred)
- Must successfully complete at least two of the four required science prerequisites before the application deadline, in order for your application to be reviewed.
- All students who are accepted into Accelerated Entry MSN will need to complete their remaining prerequisite courses prior to entering the program. All prerequisite science courses must have included a laboratory component and applicants must have achieved a grade of B- or better in all prerequisite science courses (A&P I, A&P I Lab, A&P II, A&P II Lab, Chemistry, Chemistry Lab, Microbiology, and Microbiology Lab).

Get Closer with Curry – Accelerated Entry MSN Curriculum

The Accelerated Entry MSN load varies by semester and requires a full-time commitment. Attend hybrid classes over eight-week terms each semester — alongside related clinical coursework. During the last semester, students will participate in an immersive, clinical experience, complete a capstone project as well as receive preparation for the NCLEX-RN exam.
