

FINDING JOURNALS ON THE LEVIN LIBRARY WEBPAGE

IF YOU KNOW THE NAME OF THE JOURNAL

1. Click on the "Full Text Electronic Journals List" link found under "Research Resources."
2. Type in the name of the journal in the box found **after**, "Title begins with" and click on "Search."
3. Please take note of the years covered in each database.
4. Click on the link to go directly into the database.
5. Click on the appropriate year, date, and issue (from the list on the right hand side of the screen) if you know it, or:
6. Click on the "Search within this publication link" if it is an Ebsco database. Gale databases will default to searching within the publication.
7. Enter your "keyword."
8. Note the suggested "subject topics" that are listed to the left.

IF YOU DON'T KNOW THE NAME OF A JOURNAL

You can search by subject area to locate journals.

1. Click on the "Full Text Electronic Journals List" link found under "Research Resources."
2. Use the drop down bar under "Browse e-journals by subject."
3. Highlight the subject that is of interest to you and click on "Search."
4. Scroll down to view the different categories and select the most appropriate link for your research.
5. Select your journal by clicking on the link that will bring you directly into the database.

You can search within the publication by following steps 5 - 8 as directed above.
