Diverse Perspective in Mathematics

This course focuses on seeing mathematics as a tool for understanding the world & sustaining a culture of access and equity. A critical component will be examining how an inquiry-based approach to mathematical concepts values multiple perspectives through social construction of knowledge, empowering all diverse learners. Mathematical practices that are inclusive of all racial, ethnic, linguistic, gender and socioeconomic backgrounds will be explored. Mathematical discourse, collaboration, modeling, and problem-solving will be emphasized with the use of culturally responsive manipulatives and technology.

This course will be delivered in a Hyflex Instruction format. Classes will be offered onsite in the district alongside asynchronous coursework.
