#### **Admission Requirements**

- An earned Baccalaureate degree\* from an accredited institution (undergraduate GPA of 3.0 is preferred)
- An unrestricted Massachusetts RN license
- Completion of a college-level statistics course
- An interview with School of Nursing and Health Sciences Faculty

\*RNs with a bachelor's degree in a field other than nursing may be required to take additional courses. Speak to an advisor for more information.

## Affordable Tuition for Your Budget

The current tuition is \$34,020 (approximately \$972 per credit x 35 credits) and no fees.\* Alumni receive a 20% tuition discount.
